STUDENT EXPERIENCE

- Spend a week at LIV in Durban, providing holistic residential care for children
- Worship at a local Indian church in Durban
- Visit Robben Island (where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned), Slave Lodge and Apartheid Museum
- Serve in a rural village outside Mossel Bay
- Stay overnight in Hermanus (just in time for whale-watching season!)
- Study South African history and culture, and select a module in intercultural communication or missional anthropology
